

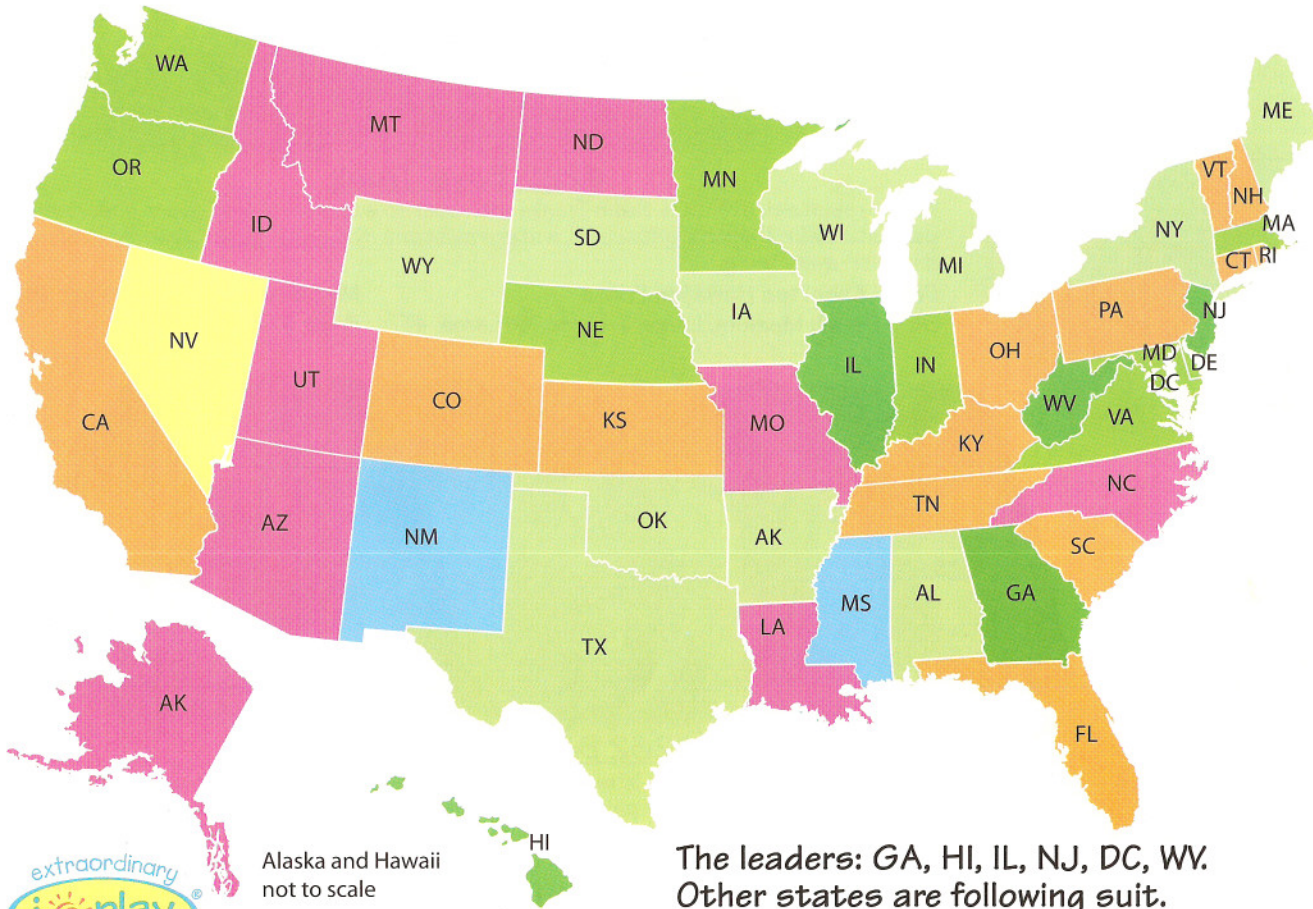
# 27 States Now Require or Encourage the Use of Approved Swim Diapers for Diaper-Aged Children Swimming in Public Pools.

Swim Diapers are no longer just a matter of preventing embarrassing accidents; instead they have become central to an important health issue.

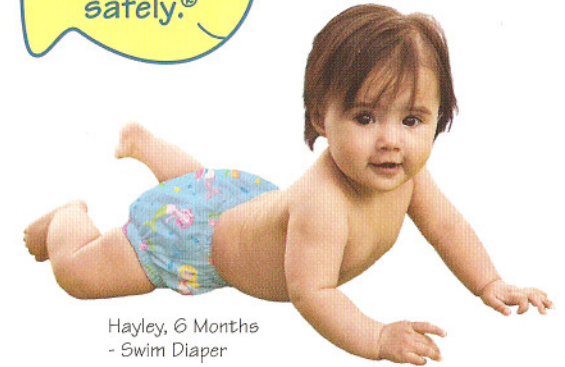
